- 1. Born in South Poland, 1922
- 2. Left home to seek safety from approaching German Army and went to the city of Lvow, Poland
- 3. USSR troops occupied Lwow, he was arrested by the KGB and transported to a labor camp in Central Siberia
- 4. Bernhard was released from the camp in 1941 and enlisted in the Polish army in 1942
- 5. He was called to duty and liberated three Polish extermination camps and one German concentration camp.
- 6. Bernhard was discharged in 1945 and was in Berlin when the war ended
- 7. He and his wife, with hopes of leaving Europe, left Germany to go to the US on April 12th, 1947 and arrived in New York on April 22nd, 1947
