Traveled to the US,  
1951

### Betty's Journey:

1. Born, 1932, in Amsterdam, the Netherlands
2. When she was 11 years old Betty and her family were arrested and sent to camp Westerbork, the Netherlands, 1943
3. They were transferred to Bergen-Belsen concentration camp in Germany in 1944
4. On April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1945 she was liberated by the Russian Army in a small town, Tröbitz, near the Polish border. Betty eventually returned to Amsterdam
5. In 1951 she traveled to the US.
