The institute will examine the history of the Holocaust and its relevance to today, using survivor testimony, literature and film to supplement, illustrate, and personalize the historical content.



Course Topics:

- ◆ Using Holocaust films in the classroom
- ◆ Persecution and Segregation, 1939-1942
- ◆ Genocide, 1942-1945
- ◆ Using survivor testimony in the classroom

- ◆ Responses to the Holocaust: Global Responses, Rescue and Resistance
- ◆ Other Genocides



The instructional staff will include Co-Directors of Education Julie Scallero and Steve Goldberg, master teachers, Holocaust survivors, second generation and outside speakers.
