

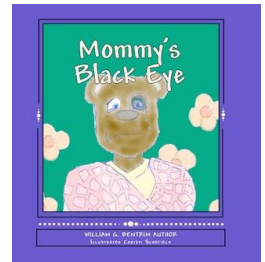
Books on Domestic Abuse

Grades 4 - 6

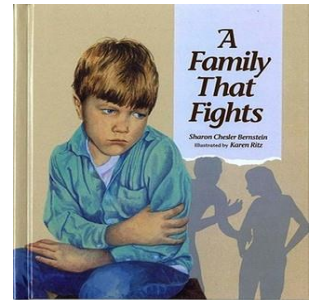
A picture book that explains domestic abuse in a child- friendly way.

Grades 1 - 3

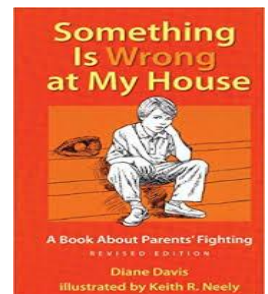
Three siblings, Henry, Claire, and Joe, become anxious when their parents fight, and worried when the fights get so bad their father hits their mother.

Based on the true story of a child who seeks help when dealing with domestic abuse at home.

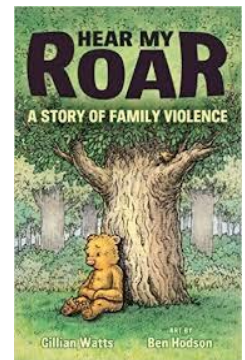


***Hear my Roar: A Story of Family Violence* by Gillian Watts, illustrated by Bed Hodson**

A story about a girl who witnesses domestic violence in her home and is forced to move in with her grandma.

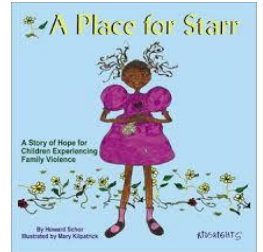


A Place for Starr: Children and Their Experience of Family Violence: A Story of Hope

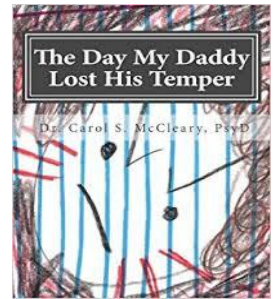

A collection of narratives from children who share their experience with domestic violence

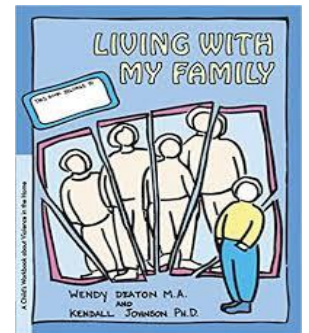
