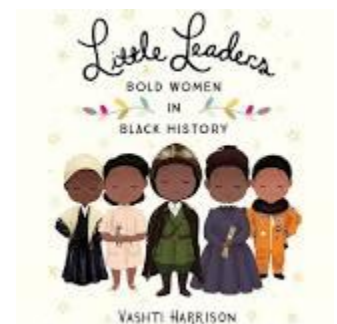


***Little Leaders: Bold Women in Black History* by Vashti Harrison**

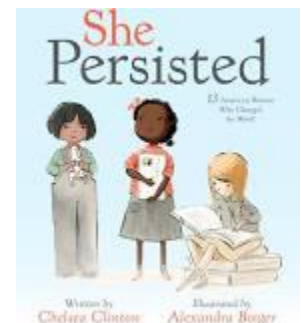


***She Persisted: 13 American Women who Changed the World* by Chelsea Clinton, illustrated by Alexandra Boiger**

A celebration of girls' strength.

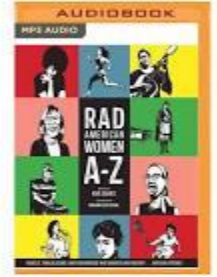


***Rad American Women A-Z: Rebels, Trailblazers, and Visionaries who Shaped our History... And our Future!* by Kate Schatz**

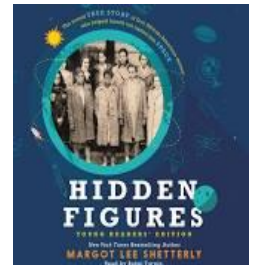


***Hidden Figures Young Readers' Edition* by Margo Lee Shetterly**

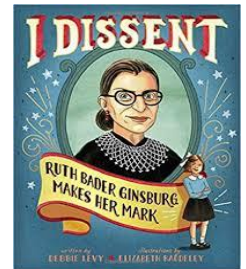


***I Dissent: Ruth Bader Ginsberg Makes her Mark* by Debbie Levy, illustrated by Elizabeth Baddeley**

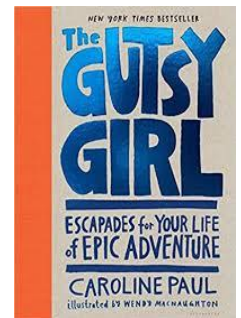


***The Gutsy Girl: Escapades for Your Life of Epic Adventures* by Caroline Paul, illustrated by Wendy MacNaughton**

The stories of girls and their thrilling adventures.

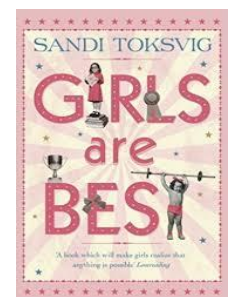

A book that looks at women's role in history regarding events in which men are celebrated.



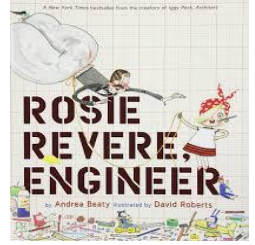
Fiction:

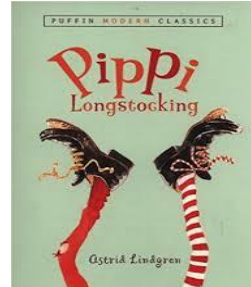


***Pippi Longstocking* by Astrid Lindgren, illustrated by Michael Chesworth, Louis S. Glanzman**

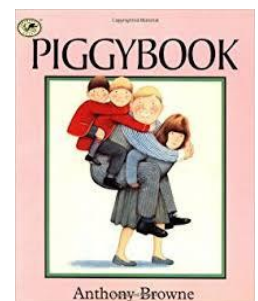


***Piggybook* by Anthony Browne**

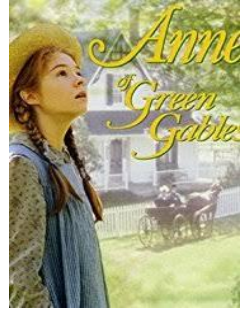


***Anne of Green Gables* by Lucy Maud Montgomery**
