

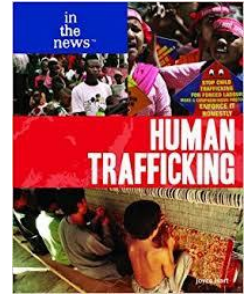

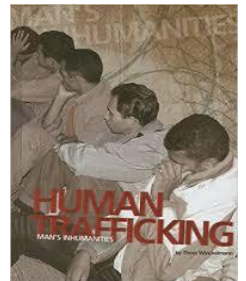

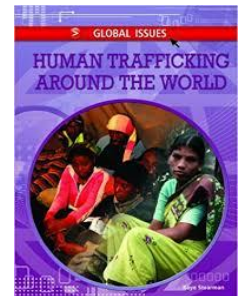


***Human Trafficking Around the World (Global Issues)* by Kaye Stearman**

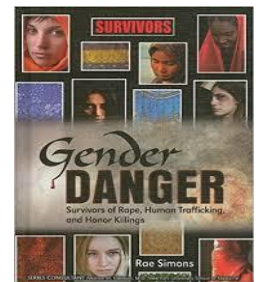
