

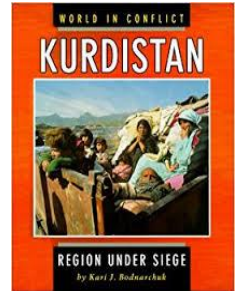

Background and information on the Kurds that relates to their ethnic conflict

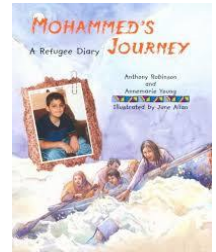


***Mohammed's Journey: A Refugee Diary* by Anthony Robinson, Annemarie Young, illustrated by June Allan**

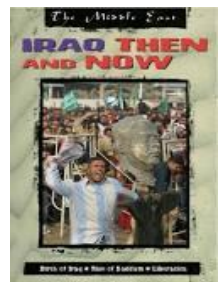


***Iraq: Then and Now (The Middle East)* by John King**

The history of Iraq and its relationship with the west, as well as under Saddam Hussein's rule.

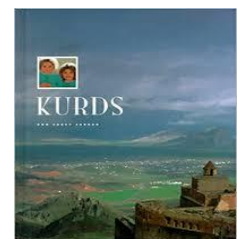

The history of the Kurdish people and their struggle to establish an independent nation.

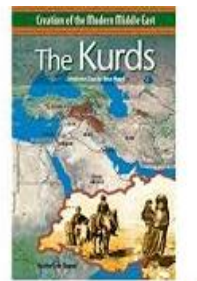


***The Kurds (Creation of a Modern Middle East)* by Heather Lehr Wagner**

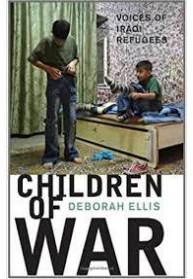


***Children of War: Voices of Iraqi Refugees* by Deborah Ellis**
