- Educational programs at the House of the Wannsee Conference, Murdered Jews of Europe Memorial, Documentation Center Nazi Party Parade Grounds and Nazi War-Trial Courthouse in Nürnberg, Polin Museum in Warsaw, Marienfelder Refugee Center Museum, Stasi Museum in Leipzig,
- Tour and educational programs at Sachsenhausen and Auschwitz-Birkenau
- Walking tours of Warsaw Ghetto and Peaceful Revolution (Leipzig)
- Tour of Kasimierz historic Jewish section of Krakow
- Discussions on Jewish life and antisemitism in Germany today and Migrant Settlement in Germany: Education, Housing, Employment, Legal Issues
- Program on tolerance education and civil society in Germany
