Teachers who are selected will be expected to attend one pre-trip seminar via Zoom in the spring of 2022 and one post-trip session in the fall of 2022.

Participants will receive a certificate of attendance for 90 CTLE approved hours upon completion of the Study Tour.

Completed applications must be sent to the Holocaust & Human Rights Education Center. There is a limit of **20** participants. There will be a rolling acceptance. A non-refundable deposit of **\$500** will be expected at the time of acceptance. The balance of **\$1800(double)** or **\$2200 (single)** will be due by **May 6, 2022**.
